**Driving Records for Resource Parents Policy**

As part of the approval process, all potential Resource parents must submit a copy of their DMV driver's record. All persons who transport children must have a valid driver's license.

Any resource parent with three or more convictions of moving traffic violations within any five year period, OR one conviction for a serious traffic violation (including but not limited to, DUI, racing, reckless driving, driving with a suspended or revoked license or vehicular manslaughter) will be ineligible for approval (or continued approval).

Exception: If a relative completes the process to become a resource parent and the only barrier for approval is the relative's driving record, the agency may approve the relative as a resource parent. Factors that will be considered are the time period and type and number of infractions. The Supervisor must approve the exception before it is applied.
